

HeartStrings Knitting Patterns — New for October 2013

HeartStrings Pattern: H95 - 3276

Swags of Lace Crescent Scarf



Adorn your wardrobe with this fluid scarf. Sparkly beads frame a crescent of interleaved chevrons of knit lace.



Finished Size 58" wingspan by 8" depth

Materials and Supplies

200 yards fingering weight yarn; shown in Crystal Palace *Panda Silk* color #5203 Biscotti
Size US 5 (3.75 mm) knitting needles suggested
432 size 6/0 (4 mm diameter) glass seed beads (approx 36 g); shown in Miyuki color #592 Ivory Ceylon

For stringing and placing beads:

- Small tapestry needle, dental floss threader or similar that is small enough to fit through the hole in beads
- Tiny crochet hook or similar that is small enough to fit through the hole in beads



Gauge Approx 22 stitches = 4" over stockinette stitch; 17 stitches = 4" over blocked lace stitch pattern

Skill Level Intermediate

Stitch Instructions Charted and written

Beading Techniques For edgings: knitting with beads strung on project yarn; for main lace pattern: placing bead on a stitch with a crochet hook or similar

Construction Bottom up, beaded loops lace edging used as basis for cast on; simple short rows; beaded bind off; no seams to sew

Fantasy Leaves Scarfette

artful knitting for your neck



Fantasy Leaves Scarfette is knitted as a long garland of leaf medallions connected by 1-cord stems.

Have fun letting a ball of yarn in slow-changing colors auto-magically transition from color to color as the leaves come off the needles.

Make as many leaves as you want (our sample model has 15 leaves).

Then wear your Fantasy Leaves artfully draped about your neck in whatever medley fits your mood or forest nymph persona.

Finished Size

90" long or length desired; each leaf is approx 6" long by 2 3/4" wide including stem

Materials and Supplies

150 yards fingering weight yarn in slow-changing colors (approximately 10 yards for each leaf); shown in Crystal Palace *Mini Mochi* color #329

Size US 5 (3.75 mm) knitting needles suggested

Gauge Approx 6 stitches/inch over stockinette stitch

Skill Level Intermediate or confident advanced beginner

Stitch Instructions Charted and written

Construction Knitted end-to-end in one piece, no seams to sew

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HeartStrings Pattern: H97 - 3282

Misty Soft

Double-sided infinity tube scarf
Smooth contour - No edges
Right-side only fabric



Shown in Crystal Palace *Mini Mochi* color #326 Citron Mist and Miyuki beads color #259 Glacier Blue-lined Crystal AB

Finished as one continuous piece, the loop can be draped casually twice around the neck as a cowl, worn elegantly over your head and once around your neck, or simply as a loop scarf.

Finished Size 52" loop by 5" wide (double thickness)

Materials and Supplies

390 yards fingering weight yarn
Size US 7 (4.5 mm) 16" circular knitting needle suggested
160 size 6/0 (4 mm diameter) glass seed beads (approximately 15 g)

Crochet hook or similar that is small enough to fit through the hole in beads

Gauge Approx 20 stitches = 4" over stockinette stitch; 28 stitches = 4" over stitch pattern

Skill Level Intermediate

Stitch Instructions Charted and written

Beading Technique Crochet hook method

Construction Worked circularly as a narrow tube; "fake grafted" seam is used to join cast on to bound off edge

Beaded Crescent Neck Lace

simple and beautiful — lace for your neck

Adorn your neckline with a crescent of color and beads. Beaded Crescent Neck Lace starts with an elegant beaded loops lace edging. Then fill out the shape with simple garter stitch short rows that let the colors of your yarn sing in accompaniment to sparkly beads. More beads edge the upper neckline in a pretty bind off to complete your neck lace.



Finished Measurements Approximately 3" at widest point; inner neckline edge 22"

Materials and Supplies

50 yards fingering weight yarn; shown in Crystal Palace *Panda Silk* color #5206 Very Berry
Size US 5 (3.75 mm) knitting needles suggested
169 size 6/0 (4 mm diameter) glass seed beads (approximately 15 g); shown in Miyuki color #451 Hematite (a.k.a. Gunmetal)

Small tapestry needle, nylon dental floss threader or similar that is small enough to fit through the hole in beads

Gauge 5 stitches/inch over garter stitch

Skill Level Intermediate knitter or aspiring advanced beginner knitter

Beading Technique Knitting with beads strung on project yarn

Construction Bottom up, beaded loops lace edging used as basis for cast on; simple short rows; beaded bind off; no seams to sew

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
