Finished Size

Approximately 3" by 5"

Note: If you would like a larger (or even smaller!) flag, just choose thicker or thinner yarn, and correspondingly sized knitting needles and beads. Plan accordingly for more or less yardage being needed.

Yarn

Size 8 pearl cotton thread or equivalent. Your yarn choice needs to be thin, yet strong enough, to carry the beads. 3 colors as follows: red - 14 yards; white - 10 yards; blue - 6 yards

Gauge

Approximately 14½ stitches per inch

Knitting Needles

Size 4/0 US (1.25 mm) needles suggested

Seed Beads

50 white size 10/0 or 11/0 (2 mm diameter)
