Perfect for the most avid kitty lovers — this knitted lap cloth or hand towel features a cute lace cat motif.

Crafty knitters, spinners and crocheters all know the value of using a towel in your lap to provide protection from stray fibers as well as give contrast for better visibility of stitches or drafting zone.

Knitted with heavy worsted or Aran weight yarn, this project proves that not all lace needs to be knit on tiny needles with teensy yarn.

Finished Measurements 13" by 22"
Materials and Supplies

215 yards heavy worsted weight or Aran weight yarn
Size US 8 (5 mm) needles suggested

Gauge 17½ stitches and 24 rows = 4" over stockinette stitch
Skill Level Advanced beginner lace knitter
Stitch Instructions Charted and written
Construction Knitted from end to end in one piece, no seams to sew
