Lace and Cables Scarf A G E

Here is a nicely reversible scarf in a beautiful organically flowing design.

An easy trellis lace stitch combines with interwoven lattice of textured knitpurl spot cables that appear to be floating.

To add to the ethereal appeal of this pattern design, our model is made in a soft metallicenhanced yarn plied with tiny glass seed beads.

Size Planned measurements are 7" by 56" after finishing with light blocking.

Width can be adjusted in increments of the 16-st multiple (approximately 2½").

Number of row repeats can be worked to length desired.

Skill Level Advanced beginner. Both charted and line-by-line written stitch instructions are provided in the pattern.

Yarn and Needles

Lace weight or light fingering weight yarn -325 yards for planned measurements. If changing width and/or length, adjust amount of yarn needed accordingly.

Knitting needles — size US 5 (3.75 mm) suggested.

Cable needle.

Gauge 25 stitches per 4 inches over finger-blocked stitch pattern.
