Lacy Maizy Wrap

Crisp outlines of cable stitches frame a back-drop of lace. The cables are carried out to each edge of the wrap, preserving the overall flow of the curving lines.

Size

12" by 70" including fringe

Yarr

600 yards fingering weight

Gauge

15 stitches = 4 inches over blocked cable lace stitch pattern

Suggested Needles

US 7 / 4.5 mm

Other Notions

Cable needle (optional)

Tapestry needle for finishing ends

Blocking board and rust-proof blocking wires/pins

For fringe: crochet hook for latching fringe onto the ends of the wrap and sharp scissors or rotary blade cutter for trimming fringe ends
