Jackie E-S redefines the traditional triangle shawl with a shallower profile worked side-to-side beginning with just


four stitches.

The cable-ribbed lace pattern softens the edges in beautifully

edges in beautifully scultped outlines.

A bonus is that the pattern is pleasingly reversible, giving you the freedom to wear this shawl in a multitude of ways that take advantage reversible, giving you that take advantage of the long, slender tails for tying or flipping.

Shown in Qiviuk Silk Blend by Jacques Cartier, 50% qiviuk/50% mulberry silk, 217 yds/28g - 2 balls, color maroon





Size 15" at point of triangle by 84"

Yarn 400 yards lace weight yarn

Gauge 22 stitches = 4 inches over blocked cable lace stitch pattern

Suggested Needles US 5 / 3.75 mm

Cable needle

Tapestry needle for finishing ends

Blocking board and rust-proof blocking wires/pins
