V-Start Triangle Lace Shawl

A flattering neckline and easy-to-knit lace patterns combine to create this appealing triangle lace shawl. Instructions are available for two sizes as well as guidance to easily adapt for other sizes.

Sizes Shoulder shawl (Full length shawl): wingspan 64 (90)"; back center spine length 27 (35)"

Yarn 600 (1200) yards lace weight

Gauge 20 stitches = 4 inches over blocked lace

Knitting Needles US 4 (3.5 mm) suggested

Other Notions

2 markers (for indicating end of panel sections) Tapestry needle for finishing ends Blocking board; rust-proof blocking wires/pins

Skill Level Intermediate or adventurous advanced beginner lace knitter

Stitch Instructions Charted and written

Construction Worked flat in rows starting at neckline and increasing to lower edge in one piece; no sewing or grafting



Shoulder shawl size in one 50g skein *Winter Lace Junior* by Mountain Colors, color Daybreak





For a different wearing option, turn back the neckline into a collar and decorate with a shawl pin
