Fleur de Lis Lace Cape

Wrap yourself like royalty in this majestic cape shawl. Beads embellish fleur de lis medallions against a background of trellis lace stitch.

The cape is worked top-down, starting with a half hexagon neckline of 3 beaded fleur de lis lace panels that continue down the front edges and center back. Increasing sections of mirrored trellis lace between the fleur de lis panels create the distinctive half decagon shape with 5 sections.

Finished Size

Length: 36" (91.4 cm) Wingspan: 80" (203.2 cm)

Yarn 1250 yards (1143 m) lace weight

Gauge $16\frac{1}{2}$ stitches and 20 rows = 4" (10 cm) over trellis lace stitch pattern

Knitting Needle Size US 7 (4.5 mm) suggested

Glass Seed Beads 492 size 6/0 (4 mm diameter), approximately 45 g

Other Notions 4 stitch markers

Tiny crochet hook small enough to fit through hole of beads

Skill Level Advanced beginner; pattern includes specifics for placing and sliding markers

Lace Panel Instructions Charted and written

Beading Technique Crochet hook method of bead placement

Construction Knitted in one piece; no sewing.
