# Alhambra Arches Lace Stole

Beaded lace borrows inspiration from the stunning architecture of Alhambra castle in Spain.

#### **Finished Size**

20" by 75" (50.8 by 190.5 cm)

#### Yarr

1000 yards (915 m) lace weight

#### Gauge

18 stitches and 29 rows = 4" (10 cm) over blocked stitch pattern

## **Knitting Needle**

Size US 5 (3.75 mm) suggested

#### **Glass Seed Beads**

386 size 6/0 (4 mm diameter), approximately 33 g

### **Other Notions**

Stitch markers (optional, but helpful in checking stitch counts)

Tiny crochet hook small enough to fit through hole of beads

Tapestry needle for finishing ends Blocking board; rust-proof blocking wires/pins
