## Moose Lace Afghan

This attractive, practical afghan is an example of "moose lace", i.e. lace knitted in a large gauge in heavier yarn. The lace makes this afghan lighter in weight for its size, yet pleasingly warm and snuggly.



**Finished Size** 40"/102 cm wide by 48"/122 cm long, or size desired (can be adjusted in multiples of 10 stitches and repeats of 16 rows)

Yarn 900 yards / 823 m worsted weight

(if resizing from measurements above, consider appropriate adjustment to yarn amount)

**Gauge** 15.5 stitches and 24.5 rows = 4 inches / 10 cm over lace stitch

Knitting Needles US 8 (5 mm) suggested

Skill Level Advanced beginner

**Stitch Instructions** Charted and written

**Construction** Worked flat in rows in one piece; no seams to sew
