## Circle of Friendship Socks



Traveling stitch cables define interconnected circles, and remind us of the friendships that abound through our knitting.

Pattern includes stitch variations for yarn in either variegated or solid colors.

The sock pictured at left was made with a variegated yarn: Lorna's Laces Shepherd Sock in color Rainbow. This will give you a good idea of how the stitch pattern shows up in a multi-colored yarn.

You may also select a solid color yarn that further emphasizes the bold relief of the stitch pattern for an even more classic look.

Instructions are given for making the twisted stitch traveling cables either with or without a cable needle.

The method without a cable needle can be applied to making any cables in general without a cable needle.

**Size** Adult medium.

### Yarn and Needles

Fingering weight sock yarn, approximately 300 yards in either a variegated or solid color.

Size 1 US (2.25 mm) double point needles, or size needed to obtain planned gauge, set of 5.

Cable needle - optional.

**Gauge** 8 stitches per inch over stockinette stitch.

**Skill Level** Intermediate to advanced knitter. This is a charted pattern. Instructions are given for making the twisted stitch traveling cables either with or without a cable needle.
